CHILD SAFETY-BLUE CARD

As a Surf Lifesaving Queensland member over the age of 18 it is a requirement for you to hold a current Qld Working with Children Blue Card, it must be Qld and not another State. Please note, these are free to volunteers/members of our Club. To apply you will need to hold a Qld Drivers License or obtain a Customer Reference Number (CRN) from Qld Department of Transport and Main Roads. As a non-QLD resident -To get a CRN you will need to present in person at the closest Department of Transport and Main Roads office with ID and apply for a CRN for a Blue Card application. The closest office to Coolangatta is at Currumbin. CRN's are usually issued on the spot.

Using your QLD license or CRN please log into

https://my.bluecard.qld.gov.au/login and complete the online portal registration.

You will get to a point and be told you need to be linked or verified by your volunteer organization and they will give you an account number.

• You will receive an email from Blue card once linked, you will need to **log back on** to Blue Card Services and finish your application



CHILD SAFETY-ELEARNING

eLearning

There are 2 Child Safe courses that all members over 18 must complete every time they renew their Blue Card. Please note, these are 2 separate courses, one to meet State requirements and the other meets Federal requirements. You can access these through the Members Area portal which you will need to make an account with. <u>https://members.sls.com.au/</u>

Finally look for the 'SLS – Child Safe Awareness' course and select 'enrol' then work your way through the course

Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) has a number of online courses available to support members in completing their SLSA awards in a more flexible manner. Currently online courses are available in the following streams: Aquatic Search and Rescue, Emergency Care, Beach Management and Powercraft. There are also Safety and Wellbeing, Skills Maintenance and Age Managers options available to be completed online.

The online courses available typically cover the theory components and are designed in many cases to be completed in conjunction with a course Learner Guide which you can access from the SLSA Members Area Library. In most cases you will also participate in practical training activities and assessments organised by your surf lifesaving club or SLS state/territory centre to achieve competency in the SLSA award.

An online version of the SLSA eLearning User Guide can be found within the SLSA IT Helpdesk Online Help Library.

- Enter your phone or email and click forgot password-reset
- Create an account with an email/phone number, different to whats listed as yours on surfguard- once in, email rto@lifesaving.com.au to Merge you and your placeholder account (get your surf club office to check if you have an account made already to merge with first)
